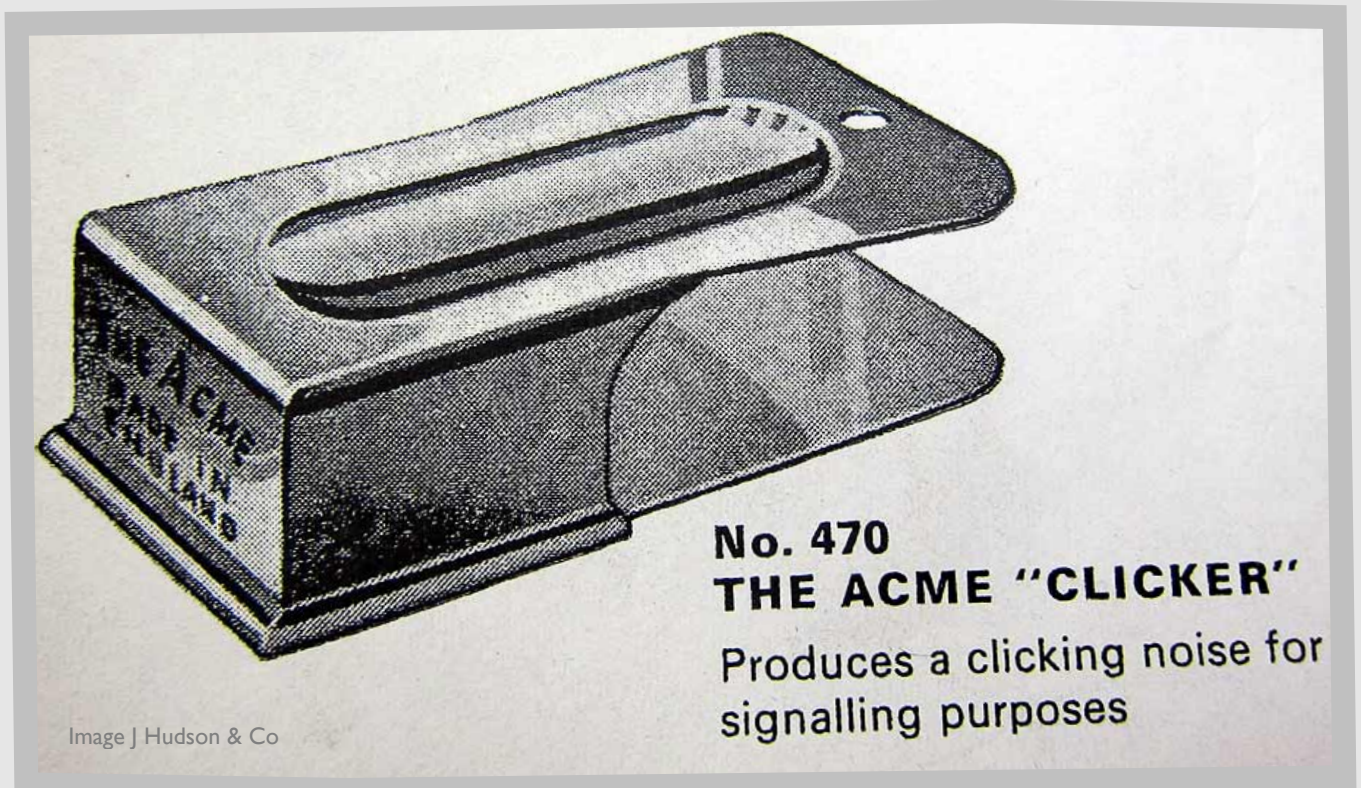


# CLICKER CODE



The ACME clicker was used by soldiers during the D-Day landings to signal to each other that they were near by. They had parachuted into France, were behind the enemy lines and wanted to avoid being captured. The clickers helped them locate each other, particularly in woodland.

## **In classroom, school hall or playground**

In pairs or groups, create a code using sounds such as clicking your finger, clapping or clicking your tongue.

Think of some easy directions, actions or instructions that you can signal to each other, for example left, right, take five steps, stand up on third click, etc.
