We will be working in Key Hill Cemetery, Warstone Lane Cemetery and St Pauls Churchyard to ensure they are free from litter, leaves and other debris.</p> <p>Seasonally we'll also be planting native bulbs and flowers in the cemeteries to provide a splash of colour and of course food for the bees at the Hive! We'll be working with wildlife and historic environment experts to encourage animals, birds and insects to thrive here in the JQ, whilst protecting the historic features including gravestones.</p> <p>Due to COVID-19 we will be observing social distancing at all times, equipment will be cleaned between uses and hand sanitiser provided.</p>
